“Cleveland’s Own Passion Play” Celebrates 35 Years

January 1, 2012; Cleveland, OH – Cleveland is a town rich with tradition. *Tetélestai*, a musical passion play presented by CPAM is a long standing tradition in Cleveland during the Easter season. This season marks the production’s 35th year of performances.

Vividly portraying the last week of Jesus’ life, *Tetélestai* offers its audience a moving way to prepare for their upcoming Easter celebrations. The production traditionally runs for eight weekends in the surrounding Cleveland area providing several opportunities to enjoy a performance. This season includes performances in various suburbs including Berea, Elyria, Cuyahoga Falls, and Gates Mills.

For 35 years, the interdenominational cast and crew have continued to share the timeless message of love presented with this play. The cast and crew are locals to the Cleveland area adding to the general feel of this production being a continuing Cleveland tradition for new audience members. Returning audience members enjoy the continuity of the veteran cast members with the energy of new cast members volunteering for their first season.

Produced locally by Cleveland Performing Arts Ministries, *Tetélestai* will be presented at Saint Agnes Parish in Elyria on March 2, 3 and 4th. Performances will be on Friday and Saturday at 8:00 pm, with a Sunday matinee at 2:00 pm. The play lasts approximately two hours with a short intermission. A reception follows each performance and affords and opportunity for the audience to meet and mingle with the cast and crew. Doors open about one hour before the performance. There is no admission charge; however free will offerings will be welcomed at the end of each performance.
