## Cleveland Performing Arts Ministries (CPAM) Mission Statement:

***We are a Northern Ohio Christian community, called by God to proclaim the Gospel (Mark 16:15) through the prayerful re-enactment of Christ's sacrifice and triumph over death. Led by the Holy Spirit, we strive to promote Christ's teachings in lives and hearts during the Lenten Season.***

## Tetélestai Acceptance Guidelines:

***The ministry of Tetélestai is led by the Holy Spirit, and welcomes all Christian believers. The acceptance guidelines are applied equally to all participants and no one role in the production will be set apart from any other.***

Acceptance into **Tetélestai** is based on the following criteria:

- a. You believe in Jesus Christ and acknowledge Him as your Lord and Savior,
  - b. You are willing and able to make the commitment and sacrifice required to be a member of the cast/crew,
  - c. You understand and accept the Mission, Guidelines and Commitment statement, and
  - d. You are not listed in the Sexual Offenders Registry.
- A search will be conducted of every adult who wishes to hold a CPAM position or be a part of any of its productions. Anyone included in the Sexual Offenders Registry will not be permitted to participate in CPAM or its productions or activities, including Tetélestai.

## Tetélestai Cast & Crew Statement of Commitment:

**As a member of the cast/crew of Tetélestai, I understand that I have been chosen by Christ to be an ambassador of His message of love. I accept this responsibility and I will:**

- attend all rehearsals and performances and will arrive on time. In the event I will be late or absent, I will notify the Executive Director and/or Production Director, by phone, as soon as possible. Any known conflicts have already been disclosed, in writing, to the Director.
- respect the authority of the Director(s) and the CCT and will cooperate with them and the CPAM officers.
- fulfill my work, school and family commitments while involved in Tetélestai. If I am a student, I will maintain grades at a level satisfactory to my parent(s) or guardian(s).
- learn my lines and music, develop my character, and learn required technical aspects of the production to fulfill my role in the ministry.
- accept all assignments, including clean-up after rehearsals and tech-out each weekend after the final performance.
- be responsible for my own transportation to and from all rehearsals and performances.
- participate in fundraising activities to the best of my ability.
- be held accountable for my words and actions and will endeavor to maintain a positive, Christian attitude.
- help nurture a loving, Christian community within the cast and crew.

I understand that if I fail to fulfill my commitment, I may be removed from the cast/crew of Tetélestai. I further agree, that should I decide I cannot be a part of Tetélestai, I will notify the Director and the Executive Director immediately.
